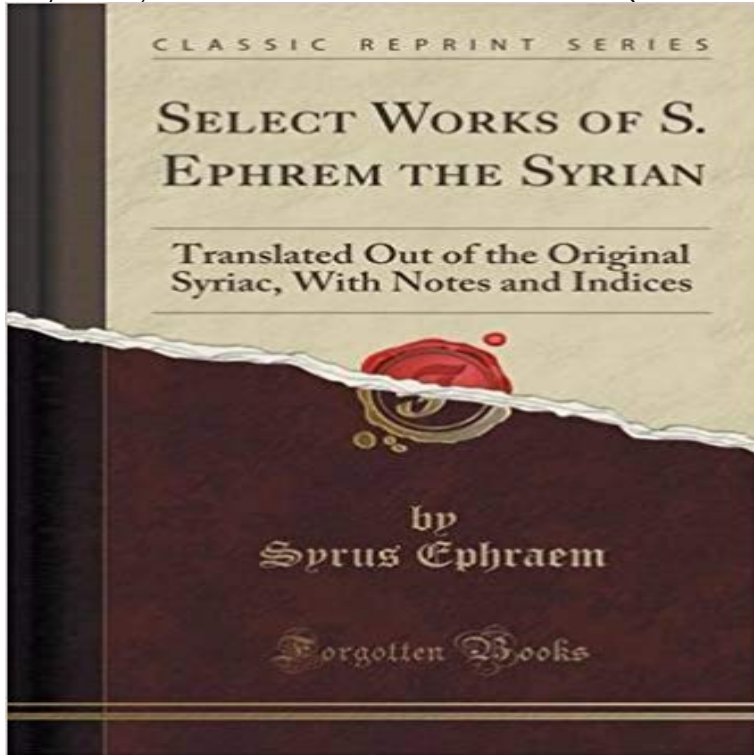

The circumstances under which the present Work appears, seems to require silence rather than explanation. It was commenced several years ago; it was finished and in type before the English Church lost its translator. Immediate duties, and subsequently, long illness, prevented the present writer from doing what little remained to be done, previous to its publication. A few words must be said upon two or three passages in the notes. In a part of the note in p. 236, (which from some circumstance this writer did not see while passing through the press,) he thought one statement perplexing, if unexplained. As Christ was Very God, and had in Him and was Himself in the Holy Spirit from the moment of His Incarnation, the Spirit, of course, did not really descend upon Christ at the Jordan; it was, for our sakes, that He seemed so to do, He being Himself Omnipresent, and so incapable of motion to a place.
